ADVICE TO WALKERS

Currently, the Department does not regard the risk posed by walkers in the countryside to be unacceptable. However, this situation will be kept under constant review; should the situation in the UK deteriorate, restrictions may be put in place.

In the meantime the Department requests that walkers follow this best practice guide:

WALKING IN THE ISLAND: BEST PRACTICE GUIDE

Visitors:

- Visitors to the Island must ensure all outdoor clothing is clean on arrival. If you are unsure, please declare this to an Officer of the Department at the port of entry and disinfection procedures will be carried out.

All Walkers:

- Ensure all footwear is spotlessly clean
- Do not stray from rights of way onto grazing land
- Do not walk amongst livestock
- Never touch or handle livestock
- Keep dogs on a lead where there may be livestock
- Use any disinfectant footpads or other facilities provided by the landowner

Never discard food in the countryside – take it home!
